### ASSESSMENT AND PLACEMENT

Each student who enrolls comes for placement testing prior to the summer program. With this plan, instructional time will not be taken up with testing. Based on the assessment results, students will be enrolled in courses that best address academic deficits. If the student does not attend a Placement Assessment session, testing will occur on the first day of school.
