

Skiing, Snowboarding & Tubing Field Trip

1) Does every student go skiing?

This year students have the option to select Tubing *or* skiing *or* snowboarding!

2) How do we get there?

We charter 2 luxury coaches with bathrooms and DVD players for the drive. Arrive at school by 7:30 a.m. (Doors will be open by 7:15 a.m. and students will report to their first class of the day – no waiting outside! This will help us keep the curb clear for our buses). If you bring your own equipment it can be stored in the lower outside compartments.

3) What do we bring?

- Lunch or cash to purchase lunch
- Gloves
- Hat
- Ski pants
- Ski Jacket
- Warm socks (Pack an extra pair for the ride home!)
- Scarf
- Goggles
- Change of clothes

Pack these items in a small backpack or duffel bag labeled with the student's name. Each piece of equipment brought by students should also be clearly labeled with the student's name.

4) Should I bring my lunch?

Yes, you can bring a sack lunch or cash to purchase a lunch in the Summit cafeteria.

5) Can chaperones attend?

Yes, we welcome some extra adult support! As space allows, parents and guardians can ride the bus with us, ski or tube with a group, or help out in the lodge. Other siblings can go, too, if a parent/guardian goes! If you're interested in chaperoning but aren't a fan of snow, we'd love one more adult to supervise our belongings in the lodge.

6) Can I ski or snowboard with my friends?

We group students with 2 or 3 others who want to do the same runs and are at a similar skill level. We try to honor your preferences. Some people take a lesson in the morning and ski with friends in the afternoon.

7) Can I go even if I don't want to ski?

Yes! Some students enjoy the bus ride up to the snow and then stay in the lodge where a couple of teachers supervise board games. However, you are encouraged to ski, board or tube. We will help beginners with their equipment and make sure everyone has a successful experience.

8) Can a student ski or snowboard even if they're a beginner?

If you are a new or beginner skier, we recommend you to sign up for the beginner class and then will be grouped with other students at your level for the remainder of the day.

9) What time will the bus get back to Morningside Academy?

We get back to Morningside at 3:30 p.m. in time for a normal dismissal. The buses will pull up on Lenora Street next to the school, so please park elsewhere while waiting for the buses!
