Monday – Introduction to Webpage Design

Morningside welcomes back Computing Kids for a new course, "Introduction to Webpage Design." Students will follow their interests and learn the fundamentals of web design and use these concepts to create their own web page. Using HTML, students learn how to structure content and insert text, images, and links to their own web pages. As students advance, they learn how to style and change fonts, add borders and colors, and much more. The class is recommended for creative learners that want to explore the world of web design from both sides of the design and programming process.



Monday – Introduction to Drama – NEW CLASS!



Join instructors from Seattle's renowned Stone Soup Theatre for an introduction to Drama. Students will experience play-acting games, do basic improvisation, and develop short scripts as they learn the basics of acting including voice projection, memorization, and basic character development. Theater work has been known to boost confidence and creativity, build a sense of community, and provide a healthy way to express emotion. After work on the fundamentals, students will perform a short play.

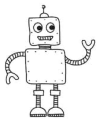
Tuesday – Indoor Interactive Games

End your school day with fun indoor activities! Students will join our Wushu instructor Rusty ("Sifu") each week to explore a wide variety of indoor games, including Paracord projects, Origami, Kirigami, foam fencing tournaments, paper airplane contests, indoor team games, partner card games, and more! Students will be encouraged to learn new games each week and explore new challenges. This is a great time to develop teamwork, good sportsmanship, and positive interactions with other students.



Wednesday – Robotics at Center for Wooden Boats

This is an extended class that offers Underwater Robotics! At the Center for Wooden Boats on South Lake Union, students will learn how to build robots, go on a field trip to MOHAI, and explore the different ways underwater robots and sailing vessels are alike in terms of adventure and exploration! In addition to building a robot, after school adventures include experiments using levers, bathymetric charts, buoyancy and more! Instructors will meet students at Morningside Academy to walk/take the Seattle Street Car to CWB at Lake Union Park, please be sure to dress for the walk and for inclement weather. The cost of transportation is included in the registration fee. The program end time is 5:00 PM in the winter. Student pick up is at the pavilion (uplands) at CWB.
