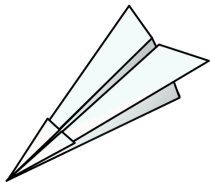

Monday - Art: The World Around Us

Join staff member Sarah in an art class where students will look to the natural world for inspiration. Students will draw from what we see and make work in a variety of materials and processes. They'll be exercising their creative muscles and learning to lean into the process of art making together. This class allows students to work on their observation skills and self-expression, as well as boost emotional intelligence with hand/eye coordination.



Tuesday - Indoor Games

End your school day with fun indoor activities! Students will join our PE instructor Rusty each week to explore a wide variety of indoor games, including Paracord projects, Origami, Foursquare variations, foam fencing tournaments, paper airplane contests, indoor team games, partner card games, and more! Students will be encouraged to learn new games each week and explore new challenges. This is a great time to develop teamwork, good sportsmanship, and positive interactions with other students.



Wednesday - Glassblowing

Seattle Glassblowing Studio instructors will meet students at Morningside Academy at 2:40pm to walk to the studio on 5th and Bell. Students will work with expert glassblowers to learn different techniques of glassblowing. An essential element of glassblowing is teamwork - either leading or assisting - so students will learn to work together to accomplish their projects. Students should be picked up at 6pm from the studio. ***Please note that students MUST be 10 or older to participate.***



Thursday - Theatre Games and Exercises

Come join instructor Mike Nevarez (actor/director/teaching artist) for an hour of fun theatre games that allow for students with any level of experience to express themselves in an encouraging and supportive environment. Students will engage in theatre-acting and improvisation games as they learn the basics of acting including voice projection, memorization, and basic character development. Participating in theatre is known to help build confidence, community, work ethic and empathy.
